Approach



IL-173 serves Richmond, Antioch and Northern McHenry and Lake County as well as S. Wisconsin. Route 173 is a key artery in northeastern Illinois. I-94 funnels traffic westbound to US-12 enroute to Lake Geneva and Western Illinois cities.

Closeup



Illinois 173 runs west to east along the northern part of McHenry county to Lake Michigan in Lake county. Along its route several major north/south highways empty into 173 such as US 14, IL 47, US 12/31, IL 59 and IL 83 along with other heavily traveled roads. This state highway connects Chicago's northwest and north far suburbs. The location is nestled in the north central part of McHenry County located about ½ mile east of US 12/31. It is found on Chicago's historic Hunt Club where it attracts hunters from all over the Chicagoland region. Motorists from I-94 exit west on 173 on their journey to Wisconsin where a lot of Chicagoland's affluent enjoy their summer and winter escape from the daily hectic pace. Over the years, residents closer to the CBD have migrated to Richmond, Spring Grove, Johnsburg and other northwest bedroom communities which allows them a more stately lifestyle.
