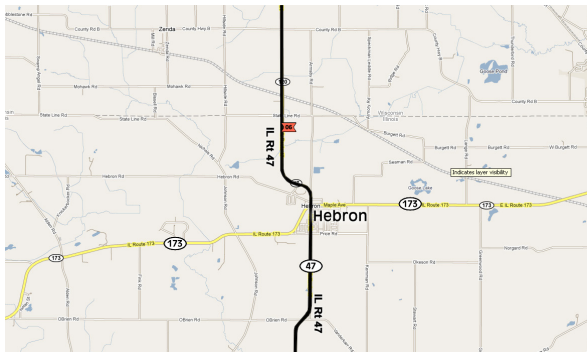

IL Rt 47 is a state route that serves McHenry county and Wisconsin (Chicago's Playland). It stems from Chicago western suburbs such as Geneva, Batavia and St. Charles and brings traffic to and from Wisconsin.

The township of Hebron is located just south of the Wisconsin State Line in McHenry County. Hebron is famous for its 1952 boy's high school basketball team that won the Illinois state championship. With only 98 students in the entire school, Alden Hebron High School holds the record for the smallest school to ever hold such a title. The water tower downtown is painted to resemble a basketball with the words "Home of 1952 State Champions". Hebron was recently featured with an article in Sports Illustrated to commemorate their accomplishment.
