Approach



Virginia Rd connects US-14 and IL-31. This major artery serves Crystal Lake, LITH and Lakewood. This artery runs between former gravel pits that are now lakes between growing cities in the Northwest Territory of Chicago. Virginia Rd is a shortcut connecting IL-31 and Rakow/Randall Rd which are the only 2 roads that can carry traffic into Lake in the Hills. This limited access is a result of the new lakes and the only business airport in McHenry County.

Closeup

The city of Crystal Lake is located near the southeast corner of McHenry County. Crystal Lake has seen its population increase significantly in the past ten years, with the population topping out at around 45,000. Crystal Lake holds a special attraction for many people because of its school system, recreation facilities, low crime rate, the Chicago and Northwestern commuter train line, civic clubs, churches, and of course, the clean 238-acre glacier-formed lake from which the town takes its name. Crystal Lake has been the hub of shopping, dining and night life in McHenry County for the past 15 years.
